#### **GCEH Committee Updates:**

##### SOAR Committee-

##### Awareness Committee-

Homeless Awareness Day was held November 19, 2009 in Jefferson City at the capitol. There were 317 posters submitted for the poster contest and there was an increase in information tables as well. This year there were three workshops held in conjunction with the event. Handouts from the workshops are available on the MASW web site and a power point of the posters is available as well.

##### Project Homeless Connect Committee-

There was a GCEH Project Homeless Connect event held in August at Columbia that was a huge success. The GCEH has decided to have an event annually with the next event being held next year in Branson. Poplar Bluff is looking into having an event.
