New Veterans Justice Outreach Program (VJO):

VA VJO Coordinators partner with local courts to identify Veterans in the Justice system in order to connect them with appropriate resources. The goal is to prevent incarceration, reduce recidivism and end homelessness among Veterans involved with the justice system. Three focus areas: courts and attorneys, law enforcement and local jails.
